PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Bichon Frise that are 6 months of age and under 15 months of age on the day of the show. Champions of Record and dogs with major points <u>are</u> eligible. **Dogs that are owned or co-owned by a professional handler may compete in this class, but must be handled by a non-professional handler.**

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES CLASSIFICATIONS

Dogs, 6 and under 9 months	Bitches, 6 and under 9 months
Dogs, 9 and under 12 months	Bitches, 9 and under 12 months
Dogs, 12 and under 15 months	Bitches, 12 and under 15 months

Winners of the 6 months through 15 months Classes will compete for Best in Puppy Sweepstakes and Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Puppy Sweepstakes. First through fourth place rosettes will be awarded in the Puppy Sweepstakes Classes. Best in Puppy Sweepstakes will receive a Pink and Green Rosette and a dog puzzle. Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Puppy Sweepstakes will receive a Lavender Rosette and a dog treat ball.

NATIONAL OWNER HANDLER SERIES COMPETITION
